Join the Bicycle Transportation Alliance, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Trimet and elected officials on a twilight bike ride along ODOT's new & improved I-205 path.

The finished path along the new MAX Green Line will connect Lents and East County to more opportunities for biking and walking, expanding transportation options while improving the health of the community. The new lights, funded by federal stimulus funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), will help ensure the path remains safe and accessible for all users.
